Recipe of the Month

Salmon Crunch Pie

This recipe came from Hugh and Ruth Armstrong. I'm salivating already and can't wait to try it!

Ingredients:

- 1 ½ cups flour
- 1 cup shredded cheese
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp paprika
- ½ cup butter
- ½ cup chopped walnuts
- 2 regular tins salmon, drained
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup sour cream
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- ½ cup grated Swiss cheese
- 1 tsp minced onion

Directions:

1. Combine flour, cheese and paprika. Cut in butter. Stir in walnuts. Mix well.
2. Reserve 1 cup for topping. Press the rest lightly into the bottom and sides of a 10" pie plate.
3. Arrange the salmon on the crust.
4. Beat the eggs until fluffy. Add the remaining ingredients.
5. Spoon this over the salmon. Sprinkle the remaining crumb mixture over the top.
6. Bake at 375°F. for 40 minutes. Serve warm or cold. Serves 6 – 8.
